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## Things you need to know

We encourage you to collect checks up front and turn them in as received. Call Frank Cagnina (813) 300-0014.

- All checks should be made payable to Clouds of Hope, (a charitable organization).
- Additional monies collected should to be turned in at registration on March 13, 2009, 6:00 p.m.
- The tournament is a two-person, nine-hole scramble: one adult and one child. Golfers should arrive at the Temple Terrace Golf & Country Club by 6:00 p.m. (200 Inverness Ave., Temple Terrace, FL 33617).
- Golf carts, glow-in-the-dark balls, and a flashlight will be provided to each team.
- All holes will be set up as short par-threes.
- Score will be kept for fun and bragging rights only. Prizes will be awarded based on donations earned.
- Golfers' families are welcome to tag along, but we do ask that each team honor the two-person, Adult-Child, scramble format to keep up the pace of play.
- Golf balls are plastic and use a Glow-in-the-Dark lightstick.
- Glow-in-the-Dark golf balls don't fly as far as a regular balls.
- Before each shot turn your golf ball so that it is struck with the club face hitting parallel to the lightstick.
- Blue lightsticks will be used to mark greens.
- Red lightsticks will be used to mark hazards.
- Flashlights are not to be used while hitting or putting. No flashlights are allowed on the green to read putts or when putting.



# Golfer's F.A.Q

### **Tell me again, what am I committing to do?**

Each two-person team is committing to raise donations in the amount of \$500-\$1,000 in support of Clouds of Hope. We realize that not everyone will reach this goal and some may even surpass it. We thank you for your participation and you can always call us with any assistance you may need.

### **What if my schedule changes and I can't make it?**

As the champion for this team, you can designate someone to take your place in the tournament (respecting the adult/child format).

### **Can I have more than one child on my team?**

Absolutely. The tournament is a scramble format and each shot should be hit by one adult and one child.

### **What should I do if I lose my golf ball or lightstick?**

Extra balls will be available. Details will be provided at the golfers meetings just prior to teeing off.

### **If I have my own cart, can I use it?**

Absolutely. Given the number of carts provided by the club we will need at least a dozen extra carts. Please let us know in advance of the tournament how you can help.

### **What should I bring with me?**

Be prepared to have fun! You will also need to bring your golf clubs, any donations that have not been turned in. And, since we will have a number of raffles and games, you may want to bring some extra cash.

### **If it gets late do we have to finish all nine-holes?**

No. Head for the clubhouse around 9:40 p.m. when we will announce the silent auction winners and wrap up the evening together.

### **Will there be an alcohol?**

No. This is a family event and we request that you not bring any alcohol of your own. But, you can bring other beverages and food if you like.

### **Will anything else be going on during the golf tournament?**

Yes. At the clubhouse, carnival style games and activities will be available for family members not wishing to participate in the golf tournament.

### **What if I don't have clubs from my kid?**

Both golfers can use the same clubs. For smaller kids, please let us know ahead of time if you think you will need a loaner.
